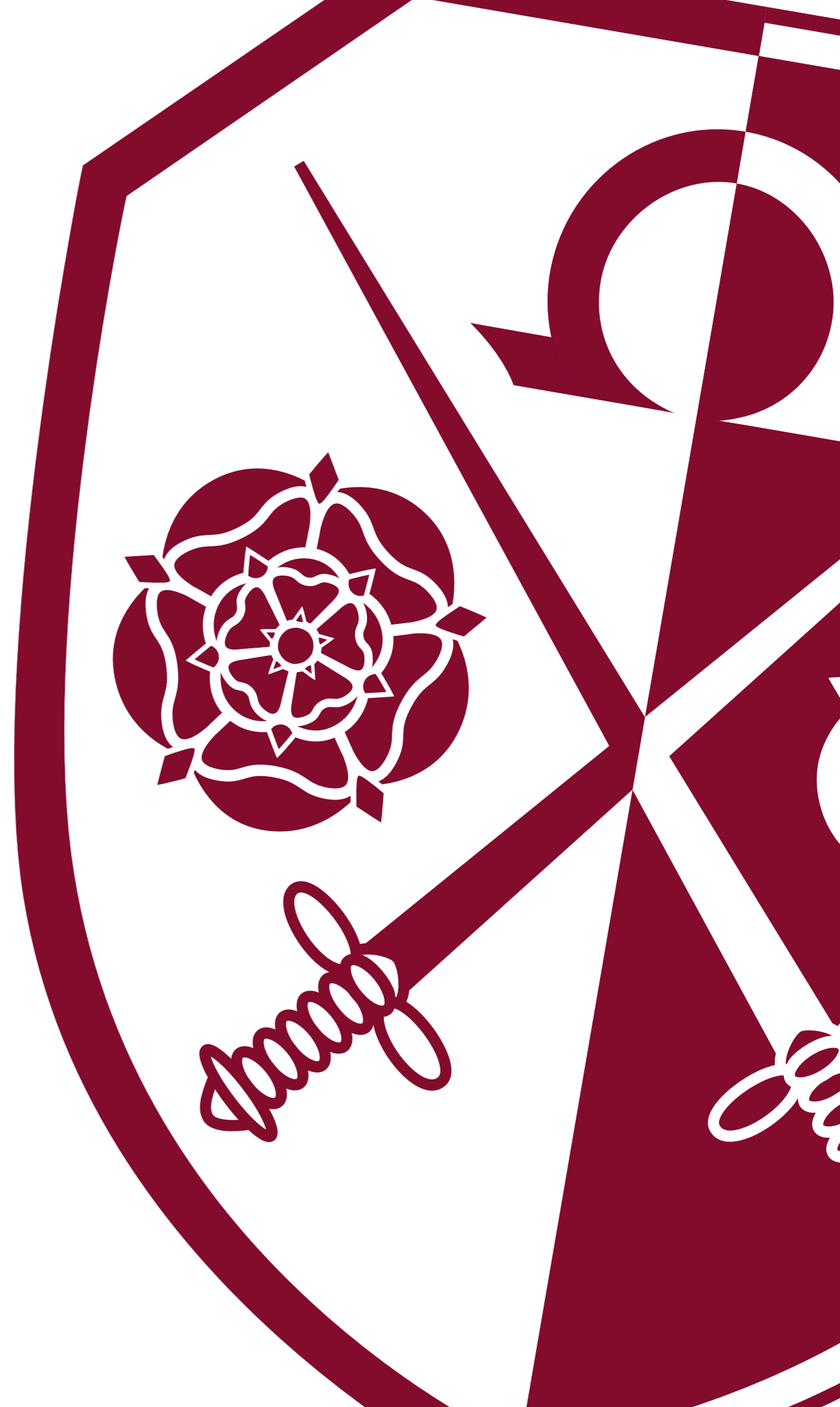
Blue indicates a level below expectations for the year group.
