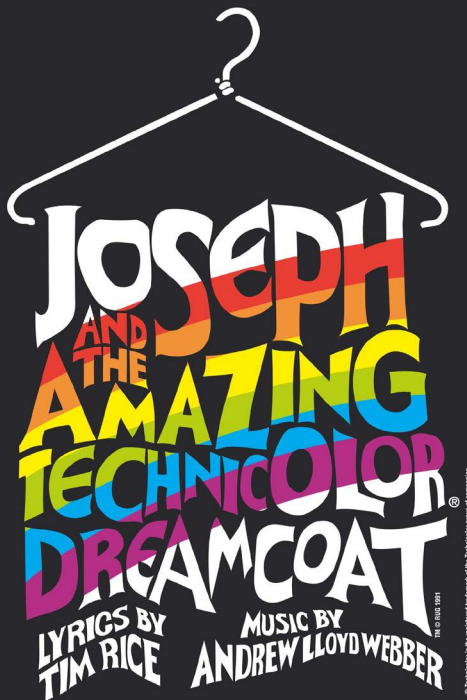

## 2019 EXAM CONTINGENCY DAY - IMPORTANT!



I would like to draw your attention to something for this year's GCSE and A Level candidates: the Joint Council for Qualifications have announced a contingency date. A contingency date is a day specifically set aside, should sustained national or local disruption arise during the June 2019 examination series. If disruption happens, the GCSE and/or GCE (A Level) examinations would be taken either for the first time or again on that day. **The contingency date for 2019 is 26th June.** Therefore students taking public examinations should not plan to leave East Barnet after A Levels before that date and students who finish their GCSEs before that date should not plan a holiday or to be at any distance from school before 27th June 2019.
