


OPEN EVENING WAS AMAZING!

CENTRALISED DETENTIONS

First, I would like to congratulate the students for the calm and purposeful environment they have created since coming back in September by consistently showing our value of 'do the right thing'. Students are focused and engaged in lessons and making the most of their time back in school. All staff members have been praising and rewarding students with plenty of House Points. Occasionally, a student may not meet our expectations by not completing homework, displaying inappropriate behaviour in the corridors, etc., this will lead to a centralised detention issued after school from 3.30pm to 4pm. If this happens, we will notify parents/guardians by text message at least an hour before the end of the school day. Students are asked to go to the detention on the same day the sanction was given. On the very rare occasion a student may forget their detention, so we give them a second opportunity to attend. If the student misses this detention, they will be set a Headteacher's detention on a Friday afternoon from 3.30 to 4.30pm. It is an absolute pleasure to have the students back under quite normal circumstances, long may it continue!
