

Dear Parents/Carers,

Sixth Form Open Evening – Thursday 25th November 2021, 6pm – 7.30pm

Students in Year 11 will soon need to make some very important decisions about their future. When they have completed their GCSE examinations, they will need to consider whether to continue with their education in the Sixth Form at East Barnet School, or at an alternative educational institution, or to follow an approved apprenticeship. These decisions could affect the rest of their lives so students will need very careful guidance.

We shall be holding our Sixth Form Open Evening at **6pm on Thursday 25th November, in the Auditorium**, for parents and students considering taking courses in the Sixth Form at East Barnet School. This is a very well attended event so please arrive in good time as the car park may be busy.

We ask that all visitors to the school complete a lateral flow test before attending Open Evening. Please can you record this on the NHS website and bring a copy of the text/email as proof. We will also accept a dated photograph of a negative lateral flow test. Whilst in the building we ask that you continue to wear a mask at all times, unless you are exempt.

During the evening, we will provide you with information about the courses which are available at East Barnet School, the application procedure for choosing them and generally what life in the Sixth Form entails.

There will be speeches from key members of staff, as well as students currently in the Sixth Form. Heads of Department will also be present to give you an opportunity to ask questions, on an informal basis, about their subject areas.

The Sixth Form Prospectus for 2022-2023 will soon be available on line, so students should study this carefully, before the evening, and come prepared with any questions for subject staff or the Sixth Form team.

I would also like to confirm that an Induction Programme to Sixth Form courses will be held for all prospective students during the period **Tues 21st, Wednesday 22nd and 23rd June 2022**. Departments will then be providing more details about their courses and helping students to make wise decisions about their final choice of subjects. **It will be essential for all students wishing to join the Sixth Form next year, to attend this Induction Programme.**
