From Friday 14th July, the way you login to the My Child At School web portal and mobile app will change, simplifying the process and making it easier to access the service.

Bromcom are removing the need to enter the School ID and your username. Going forward you will simply need to enter your email address and password to login. Your email address is the one that we have associated with your contact details on your
